Register your child for Kindergarten from the comfort of your own home at www.pwpsd.ca/registration. Those without Internet access should contact the school for assistance. A birth certificate and proof of residency are requirements for in-person or online registration.

SCHOOL START-UP:

Some schools begin the school year with staggered entry – introducing small groups of Kindergartens to the school on different days – while others choose to delay the start of Kindergarten until after older students have settled back into the school routine. In August, start-up dates and times are posted under the “Registration” link on school websites.
