GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

The Board approves of the Corporate Treasurer's membership in:

1. The Association of School Business Officials of Alberta;
2. The Association of School Business Officials International; and
3. Other such organizations as approved by the Board.

The Board approves of the Corporate Treasurer's attendance at:

1. The Alberta School Boards' Association conferences and meetings;
2. Meetings and conventions of the Association of School Business Officials of Alberta;
3. Provincial or Peace Regional meetings set up by Alberta Learning, Alberta Infrastructure, ASBA, universities, or zone or area meetings when related to the responsibilities of the Corporate-Treasurer;
4. Association of School Business Officials International conferences every second year; and
5. Attendance at additional conferences will be as approved by the Superintendent.
