POLICY JC – School Councils

The Board recognizes the importance of School Councils and will provide support and resources to enable them to fulfil their advisory function.

PURPOSE

To encourage and enable communication and collaboration between parents, the community and the school in support of education.

GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

1. The Board encourages and supports the important contributions that parents make toward the education of students.
2. The Board will allow the School Council access to timely, accurate and publicly available board information including board policies and minutes of board meetings.
3. The Board may provide annual grants to School Councils and support their involvement in Alberta School Councils' Association activities. Funding provided to School Councils is for the purpose of School Council operations and related parental education opportunities.
4. School Councils are expected to provide the Board with annual reports prior to September 30 of each year. The report should include an outline of their activities from the previous year and a complete financial report
5. Copies of the minutes of each school council meeting must be maintained and available for access by the public and the Board.
