



WHAT?

The CONNECT program seeks to develop support structures for student learning by facilitating different models of learning while maintaining the rigor of classroom instruction.

The CONNECT coordinator, in conjunction with the CONNECT supervising teacher and the student, develops the student's learning plan according to the individual student's needs. Because each student is different, each plan is different. Our goal is to personalize learning.



HOW?

To provide students with opportunities for learning in line with the 21st century, the program consists of supporting students with a hybrid model combining elements of face-to-face instruction with technology.

This hybrid model is designed to provide opportunities to partner traditional learning with the student-directed model in order to maintain rigor of program and accountability of the student.

Students are assigned to a PWA course specific supervisor, to support their learning.

Students work with different models of technology based materials at an individual pace.

WHY...

Extension: When a student needs more time to master the outcomes, the course may be extended into the next semester.

Recovery: A course is finished but the student was unsuccessful at meeting all of the outcomes. The teacher identifies one chapter or section that caused difficulties, the student can redo that section.

Redirection: Student enrolls in CONNECT to take an entire course. Often this is because the student has a timetable conflict or wants a course we don't offer in the traditional classroom setting.

Acceleration: Student would like to accelerate through a course at their own pace to finish early.
