

# **Kassia Weiss Memorial Scholarship**

## **1. Objective**

- a. To give recognition to a student who has demonstrated maturity, responsibility and overall strong citizenship both within and outside of school.
- b. To foster and encourage responsible citizenship
- c. To have a high level of respect for environment and others and to show respect by their actions.

## **2. Award**

\*A two thousand dollar scholarship (\$2000)\*

## **3. Eligibility**

- a. A graduate of Savanna School
- b. Who has met the Alberta Graduation requirements
- c. And has been accepted into post secondary education

## **4. Application Process**

Applications will be considered complete with the following contents. Complete applications can be handed in to either principal at Savanna School or emailed to Karen Weiss at [silverkranch@hotmail.com](mailto:silverkranch@hotmail.com)

- a. Applicant must provide a letter discussing the following criteria and why they should be chosen for the scholarship
  - Responsible citizenship and academic performance
  - Interest in preservation of the environment
  - How the applicant intends to make a positive impact in the world they live in
- b. Applicant must also provide a transcript of their high school grades. An unofficial transcript will be available.
- c. Applicant must provide an acceptance letter to their program of study.

**Application deadline is June 25. Exception for 2018 – deadline is extended to July 6, 2018**

## **5. Selection Process**

- a. Criteria
  - a. Responsible citizenship and academic performance
  - b. Interest in preservation of the environment
  - c. Enrollment in a program of post secondary education
- b. A committee comprised of at least one family member of Kassia Weiss, member of the Savanna Agricultural Society, and a representative of 4-H.
- c. Applicants will be informed of the decision at the Savanna School Graduation ceremonies.
- d. Money will be dispensed after successful first semester marks from secondary institution are received by the committee
