



The 'Savanna School Council Arts Scholarship' is given in the amount of \$250.00 to one student at Savanna School each year.

Scholarship Requirements

1. The applicant must be a grade twelve student attending Savanna School who has been accepted in a post-secondary program.
2. While at Savanna School the students must have participated in any area pertaining to the arts, whether it be drama, photography, music, dance, creative writing, or design including computer graphics, video-making and/or editing, etc.
3. The successful applicant will have completed a 500-word essay relating their interest in the arts. In the essay they must tell how they have already participated in the fine arts and how they will participate in fine arts in the future. It is a medium through which to convey past involvement or achievement in fine arts.
4. Preference will be given, but not absolutely necessary, to students who are pursuing the fine arts in their secondary education. Academic standing will be judged in the case of a tie.
5. The deadline for submission of the application will be June 20.
The scholarship will be awarded at the graduation ceremony.
