January Final Exam Rules and Procedures

1. **All textbooks, materials, etc., related to subject exam are to be returned to your classroom teacher or the designated spot in the exam room, prior to writing any examinations.**
2. Students are to be prepared with their own exam writing materials, no borrowing will be allowed. Check with your teacher ahead of time to determine exam writing materials required.
3. **All students** will be required to remain in the exam room for a minimum of **one and one half-hour**.
4. When finished writing, **Senior High** students are to report to designated study area in the Library or *sign out* and leave the school. No loitering in the hallways, other exams and classes will be in progress!
5. All students are to bring some appropriate quiet reading materials to be read if there is any time left between the conclusion of the exam and the allowed time to leave the exam room.
6. Students are not to leave their desk during the exam. If a student needs something, or has completed their exam, he or she is to raise their hand. A supervising teacher will then go to the student's desk.
7. Students are not permitted washroom breaks, unless an emergency exists. In the case of an emergency, the student will be escorted into the washroom by one of the supervising teachers.

8. Students will be directed to designated seating in the exam room for their exam. Desks, tables and chairs are not to be moved in any exam room.
9. **Cell phones and iPods** are strictly prohibited from being in the exam room. To keep in line with Diploma and Achievement Exam rules, any student found to have a cell phone or iPod on their person during any final exam (School or Government) will be removed from the examination room and issued a mark of 0% (zero percent) on that section of the exam.
