

Bob Chambul Central Peace Oilman's Association Scholarship

Note: For a student from Spirit River Regional Academy only

In 2009 the Central Peace Oilman's Association established a \$5,000 scholarship trust fund in the memory of Bob Chambul, long time resident from the Woking area. Bob was involved in both the oilfield and agriculture industries for his entire lifetime.

From the earnings of the fund, an annual award of approximately \$500.00 will be paid to a qualifying student from Spirit River Regional Academy. Priority will be given to a student who enrolls in an accredited post-secondary institution in Canada that offers a trades program in oilfield, mechanical field or agriculture.

The award is presented at the Annual Awards Ceremony at Spirit River Regional Academy held in September of each year.

The award is based on:

1. Priority will be given to the students enrolled in a trades related program (minimum of one year) in the oilfield, mechanical field or agriculture industry.
2. Personal letter/essay (one page maximum) indicating why the applicant is a valuable member to the community.
3. Qualities of good citizenship.
4. Student success in CTS: Industrial Education

All applicants must submit:

1. A completed application form,
2. A personal letter/essay,
3. Proof of enrolment and acceptance at a post secondary program.
