

Willie Janssen Scholarship

Note: For a student from Spirit River Regional Academy only

In 2011, the Estate of the late Willie Janssen, a long-time resident from the Woking area, gave Spirit River Regional Academy \$50,000 for a Scholarship to be setup for students enrolling in an accredited post- secondary program.

From the earnings of this fund, an annual award of \$500 will be paid to a qualifying student from Spirit River Regional Academy.

This award will be presented at the Annual Awards Ceremony at Spirit River Regional Academy held in September of each year.

The award is based on:

1. Effort and dedication to educational studies (not necessarily the student with the highest marks)
2. Financial need
3. Personal letter/essay (one page maximum) illustrating need as per items 1 and 2 above.

All applicants must submit:

1. A completed application form (complete all parts)
2. Reference letter from a teacher or administration
3. Proof of enrolment and acceptance at a post-secondary program.
